December 9

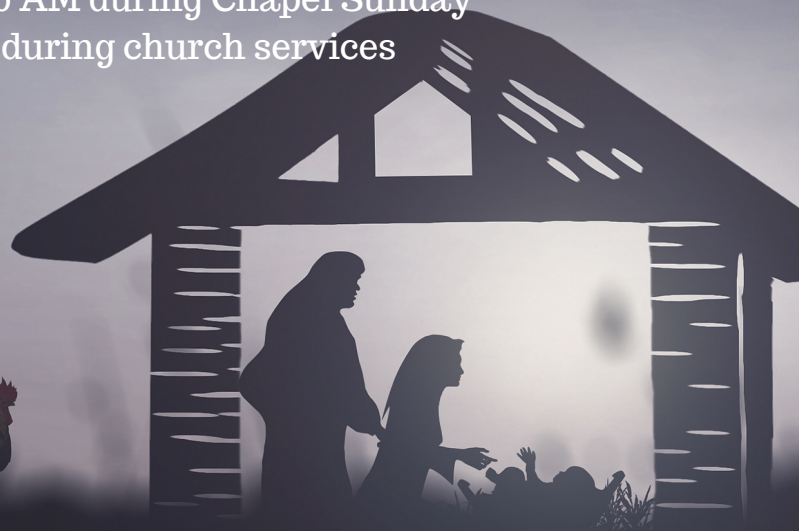

November is National Literacy Month, and we are ready to celebrate our love of books!

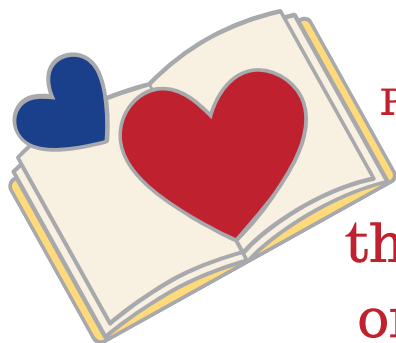
The students (and even some teachers) at St. Mark's Episcopal Academy will be dressing up to represent their favorite storybook characters.

This tradition dates back to the 1980s.

So, dust off those books or take a trip to the library and find a fanciful, adventurous, funny, or even inspirational character to bring to life!

- The character must be from a book they have read recently (not just from a movie or cartoon they have watched), and your child should be prepared to describe both the character and the book.
- Your child will need to bring the book with them to school on Storybook Dress Up Day.
- Please work with your child to plan a simple costume, there is no need to purchase anything elaborate.
- Students do not have to participate but will need to be in uniform if they do not.
- All students participating must get their teacher's approval for his/her character no later than Friday, November 11th.
- Students will participate in classroom activities celebrating with their favorite books and a storybook character parade.
