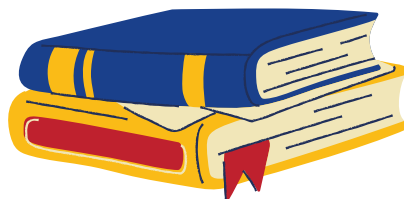
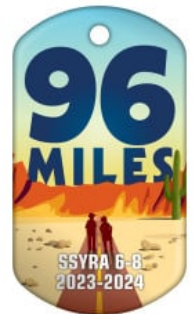

Dear Parent,

This letter is to inform you that we are taking part in Honor Their Courage, a program focused on Veterans Day. Launched in 2020, this initiative by Wounded Warrior Project® (WWP) utilizes Veterans Day to teach students in K-12 about the history, sacrifices, and experiences of service members.

Wounded Warrior Project is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization whose mission is to honor and empower injured veterans. Since its founding in 2003, WWP has been transforming the lives of America's injured veterans and their families through programs and services in mental health, career counseling, and long-term rehabilitative care, along with advocacy efforts, improving the lives of millions of warriors and their families.

Through this initiative, WWP is providing downloadable lesson plans and activities for your child to learn age-appropriate information about Veterans Day, including material on military values, reading lists, social and emotional learning, and word association exercises. WWP is also providing custom videos to support the above activities and value discussions lead by warriors on the core tenants of the military: Commitment, Honor, Courage, Service, and Integrity.

We can incorporate school-focused activities to bring our school community together for a good cause. There is an optional fundraising component through Honor Their Courage. 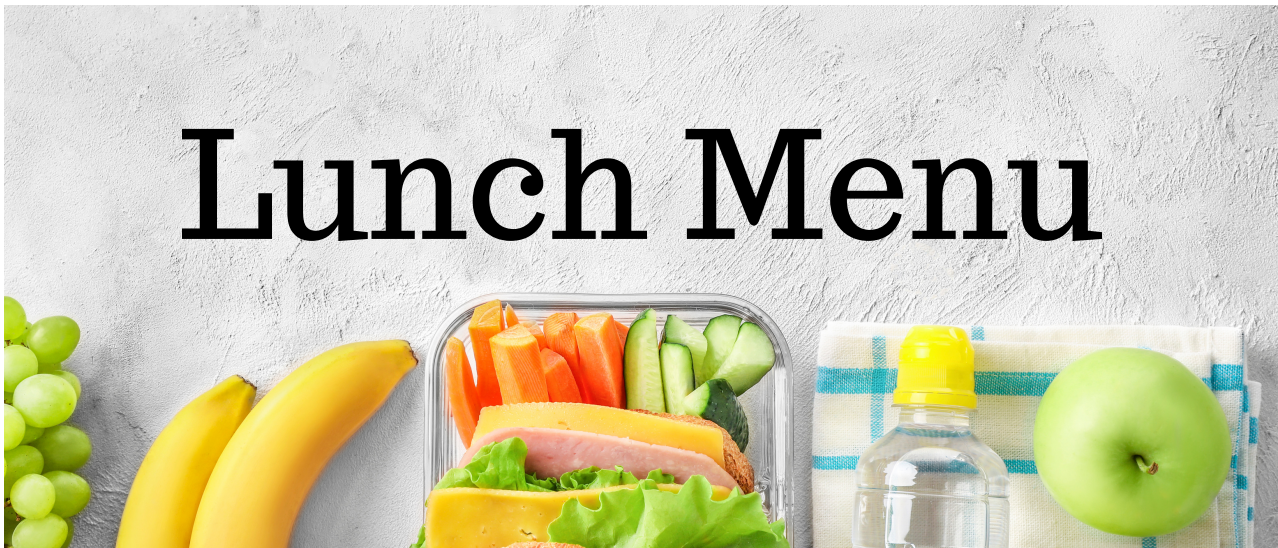
